The American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) was formed in 1920 with the goal of defending individual liberties and rights granted by the US Constitution. The Red Scare created in Americans a sense of paranoia that demanded persecution of any suspect that professed Communist ideas.

Being a nonprofit organization, ACLU receives support from many groups and citizens to support the litigation and lobbying work with legislators and government officials.
